Re: 2025 Official Opening Oneida County ATV/UTV Trail System & Enterprise Campground

The Oneida County ATV/UTV Trail System (as administered by the Oneida County Forestry, Land and Recreation Department) will officially open for the 2025 Spring/Summer/Fall season effective 12:00 noon, Thursday, May 8, 2025. This includes the trails maintained by the Hodag 4-Wheelers and Pel-Cho Mudd Nutz ATV-UTV Clubs in the Towns of Enterprise and Monico, the Little Rice ATV Club in the Little Rice & Lynne townships, the Lakeland ATV Club trail in the Town of Woodruff and the Nokomis ATV Club trail in the Nokomis and Woodboro townships.

Trails are in early season condition and may be wet in spots, so please use caution.

The Enterprise Campground will open at 12:00 noon on Thursday, May 8, 2025. The Enterprise Campground is located within the Oneida County Forest approximately 11 miles south of Rhinelander on Shingle Mill Road.
